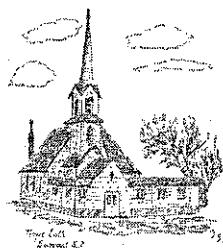

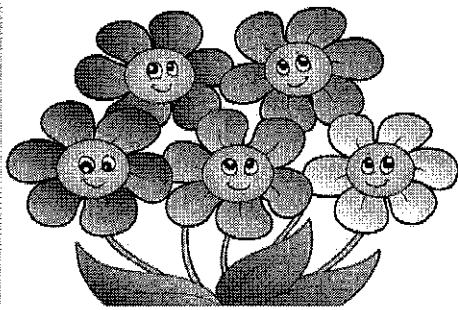

Youth to Attend ELCA Youth Gathering in Houston

Early on Monday morning, June 25th, Pastor Justin and Adriann Frankenhoff will be accompanying 8 youth from Hope Lutheran Church as they begin their journey to the ELCA Youth Gathering in Houston, TX. Thank you to Adriann for volunteering to be our second adult leader. We will be travelling with many other congregations through Lutherans Outdoors of South Dakota (7 buses total). 1,382 total youth and adults will be attending the gathering from the South Dakota Synod. Our synod has had the largest attendance out of all of the 65 synods during the past few gatherings.

The theme of the Gathering this year is “This Changes Everything.” Throughout the week, we will be hearing from some amazing speakers and musicians, spending a day doing a service project in the Houston area, in Bible Study with the other kids from South Dakota, learning about different aspects of the church, and exploring the Houston area. During closing worship, our group was selected to serve as Communion Assistants and will be part of the team distributing the sacrament to the some 30,000 youth in attendance. It should be quite the experience. We will return the following Monday on July 2nd.

I want to personally thank you for your generosity in supporting the youth of this congregation. Because of your support we have had all the funds raised for months and have actually built up the Youth Group fund already preparing for the group to attend. Thank you to the parents who have donated time and money and food for our various fundraisers and for entrusting your children to Adriann and myself for the week. You have raised great kids and we look forward to a great week with them.

Finally, thank you to the youth who have signed up for this Gathering. Thank you for taking a week out of your summer, to spend with each other, to spend with God, and to grow in your faith. We are blessed here at Hope Lutheran with some incredible youth! PERSONAL CARE KITS

- One (1) bath-size towel (approximately 27" x 52", dark color preferred)
- Two (2) bath-size bars (4-5 oz) of soap, any brand, in original wrapping
- One (1) adult-size toothbrush in original wrapping, or sealed in business-size envelope—no plastic bags or wrap
- One (1) sturdy comb, packaging removed
- One (1) metal nail clippers, remove packaging

Do not add other items or leave out any of the items listed. All items should be new and in good condition. Wrap all the items in the towel and tie securely with ribbons or yarn. Do not enclose Kit or any of its items in plastic bags.
