

Town of Summit

The Town Board met in regular session on March 5th, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. at the town fire hall. President Frank Eccles, members Kathleen Quale & Dale Bauer all were present. Others present were: Norma Arend-finance officer, Arlo Anderson, Calvin Pies, David VanElsacker, Korey Ware, Scott Ulm and Jennica Pottebaum.

Eccles called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Public communications: A complaint was heard regarding the moving of snow at the campground which should be the responsibility of the campground. A complaint was also discussed regarding the opening of residential streets before main street is 100% complete.

Motion by Eccles, second by Quale to approve the minutes, financial reports and claims as presented. Motion carried. *Insert Claims

Old Business: Scott Ulm turned in a building permit and variance for his existing fence as required by the court. A hearing will be held April 2nd for the variance.

Delinquent water bills were discussed.

Water, sewer & garbage rates were reviewed again for the school, campground and Coffee Cup based on water usage. The water and sewer rate for the school, campground and Coffee Cup will be \$4.00 per 1,000 gallons used. The garbage rate for the Coffee Cup will remain the same. The garbage rate for the school and campground will be \$125 per month per dumpster.

New Business: Korey Ware, candidate for Roberts County Sheriff, was in attendance to introduce himself and ask and answer questions.

A public hearing for a 1 day liquor license at the hall for the (Summit Area Economic Growth) SAEG was held. This is for the pinochle tournament on April 7th. Motion by Quale, second by Bauer to approve the 1 day liquor license as long as the SAEG provides their own security. All aye. Motion carried.

A public hearing for a 1 day liquor license at the hall for Sprouts Community Daycare was held. This is for a fundraising event on March 24th. Motion by Quale, second by Bauer to approve the 1 day liquor license as long as Sprouts Community Daycare employees provide their own security. All aye. Motion carried.

Dates for the Town clean-up will be discussed at the April meeting.

Motion by Eccles, second by Quale to approve the 2017 annual report for the Town of Summit as presented. Motion carried. *Insert Annual Report exhibits 1-3

The SAEG will turn in the application for the annual SD Paint the House if they decide to apply this year.

The April election is cancelled as Dale Bauer was unopposed.

A hearing will be held at the April 2nd meeting for the 1 day liquor license application for the Summit Booster Club (operating under the SAEG) for May 5th at the hall for a Second Chance Prom. The Booster Club will provide the security for the liquor license.

The equalization meeting will be Tuesday, March 19th at 7pm. Appointments must be made by March 15th with the finance officer to challenge an assessment and attend this meeting.

Motion by Eccles, second by Quale to adjourn meeting. Motion carried. The next regular town board meeting will be Monday, April 2nd, 2018 at 7:00pm at the town fire hall.
