

## Town of Summit

The Town Board met in regular session on June 7th, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. at the town fire hall. President Frank Eccles present and members Kathleen Quale & Dale Bauer present. Others present were: Norma Arend-finance officer, Arlo Anderson, Calvin Pies, David VanElsacker, Larry Hayworth, Jim Thurman, Denny Jensen, Steve Christofferson, Kevin Christofferson, Donn Richter and Dena from the Wagon Wheel.

Eccles called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Public communications: Dena from the Wagon Wheel asked if the bar could have a street dance on Friday, July 16. The street will be blocked off by the bar. The board approved. Larry Hayworth asked if they could have a food truck on Sundays at the campground during their music bashes. The board approved. A copy of the food truck sales tax license needs to be turned into Norma. A letter will be sent to Bill Thrun regarding his noxious weeds and his semi's being in the right of way. Denny Jensen requested the flushing hydrants sign be put up on main street when hydrants are being flushed.

A letter from Sandy Christofferson was read. She is requesting that the mobile home sitting on Calvin Pies camper lot be removed. Motion by Eccles, second by Bauer to have Calvin remove his trailer on this lot within 5 months of this meeting. Quale voted nay. Motion carried.

Daycare report which was sent via email by Jennica was read to the board by Norma. Poker run fundraiser will be held June 26<sup>th</sup>. Dakota Wind Range donated \$6000+ to the daycare last month.

City maintenance report was given. Kathy would like Dave to obtain some filtration system estimates. Bituminous Paving will be starting the paving project for areas around the school by the end of the week. It will take 2-3 days to complete. Dave is retiring effective June 30.
