The Town Board met in regular session on November 6th, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. at the town fire hall. President Frank Eccles present, members Kathleen Quale & Dale Bauer present. Old Business: Update on Court hearing regarding Town vs Scott & Julie Ulm completed on November 6<sup>th</sup>. Frank Eccles and Kathleen Quale attended along with attorney to represent the Town of Summit. The court ordered that Ulm's would need to obtain an approved building permit for their fence and it would need to meet all city requirements. Also they would need to remove all unlicensed vehicles from their residential property. This would need to be completed within 45 days of the judge's signed order.

Delinquent water bills were discussed.

<u>New Business:</u> April Buller from Clark Engineering was in attendance to go over the maps with street signs for the 2019 sign project.

The Summit School water, sewer & garbage rates were discussed due to the old gym being taken over by the SAEG. The new gym rate will be the same as the old gym rate.

Daycare income and expense were reviewed. The childcare income is still not covering payroll at this time.

We are still having issues with the pump from Milbank Winwater and it needs to be returned. The Town will not pay for this pump at this time.
