

Town of Summit

The Town Board met in regular session on April 2nd, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. at the town fire hall. President Frank Eccles present, members Kathleen Quale & Dale Bauer present. Others present were: Norma Arend-finance officer, Arlo Anderson, David VanElsacker, Jeff Quale, Galen Cardwell, Scott Ulm & Michael Crawford.

Eccles called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Public communications: none

Motion by Quale, second by Eccles to approve the minutes, financial reports and claims as presented. Motion carried. ***Insert Claims**

Old Business: Delinquent water bills were discussed.

New Business: A hearing was held for a variance requested by Scott Ulm. Residents within 150 feet of Scott Ulm's residence were previously mailed notices for this hearing. The variance was requested for Ulm's existing fence which is 1.5 feet higher than the Town's ordinances allow. The fence also needs a variance for setback not being met as follows: 10ft on south side, 4ft on east side and 6 inches on the west side. Quale is abstaining from the vote as she owns property adjacent from Ulm. Motion by Eccles, second by Bauer to allow the variance for the fence as long as the fence is moved in 10ft on the south side. Motion carried. It is requested fence move be done by June 1st. Motion by Eccles, second by Bauer to approve the building permit for the fence as long as the fence is moved as stated. Motion carried.

A hearing was held for the Summit Booster Club's (operating under the SAEG) request for a 1 day liquor license at the hall (old gym) on May 5th. Motion by Eccles, second by Quale to approve the permit as long as the Booster Club provides its own security. Motion carried.
