


# What's Going On?


There are a lot of things coming up in November and we want you to mark your calendars and of course join us!



- -Don't forget to FALL back on November 7, 2021!!!



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

My friend, who is a third grade teacher, told me a story of a special homework assignment from last year. She had assigned her students the job of bringing a picture of "Thanksgiving".

The kids did a great job. Some brought pictures of their family gathering with lots of people around tables smiling and eating feasts. Some brought pictures they made of pilgrims and native Americans to represent the first Thanksgiving meal. Some even brought pictures of people praying their thanks.

But, one little girl had something different. On her page, she had pasted pictures of people working, One was people serving at a homeless shelter, one was people picking up trash on the highway, and one was people helping out at a nursing home. Thinking the child misunderstood the assignment, my friend asked her to come over quietly and talk about her paper. Her answer was pretty awesome.

"In my house, if someone does something nice for you, you need to either write a thank you note or do something nice in return. Just saying "thanks you" doesn't mean much. But, DOING "Thanks you" leaves a feeling that lasts. So, all these people are "doing" thanksgiving. They are thankful so they are doing something about it. "

The story comes to mind as we approach our Thanksgiving holiday. This year, I give you a challenge. Ask yourself, "what am I actually thankful for today?" Using the little girl's measurement, think about how you can be "DOING" thanksgiving. How can you serve God and the people of your community to show that you are truly thankful for your blessings?

This year, remember that just saying thanks to God can be an empty thing if you are not also "doing " thanks to God.
