It doesn't seem like that festive holiday time of year should be here yet to me. I'm not quite ready for it. I know I'm not alone in the feeling. Many of you have experienced the empty seats at the Thanksgiving table, and though of the presents you won't buy, make or wrap for the person you love. Though we go on with our regular lives and deal with the trials that can cause grief, there's something about the holiday season that brings it back.

But, ready of not, we approach the season of Advent in the church. Advent- the season of waiting, the season of readying ourselves. Advent is a season of endings and beginnings. As the calendar year comes to a close on Christ the King Sunday, a new church year begins. 

Meeting closed with the Lord's Prayer.




# 2024 Monthly Offerings vs Budget







