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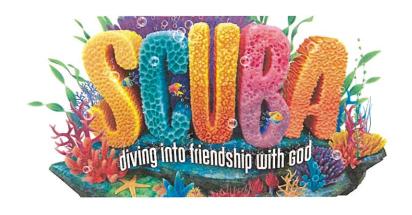

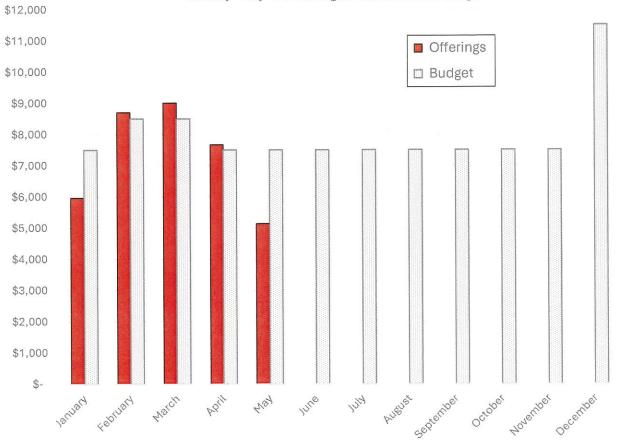

January - May YTD offerings are \$3008 below budget



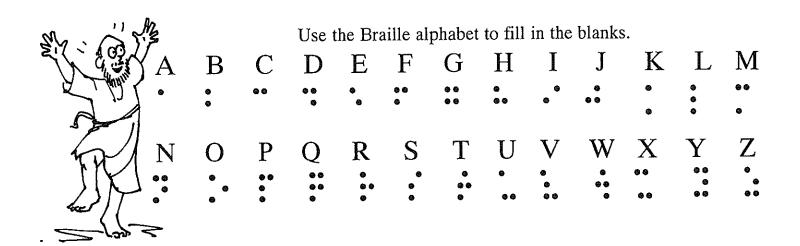

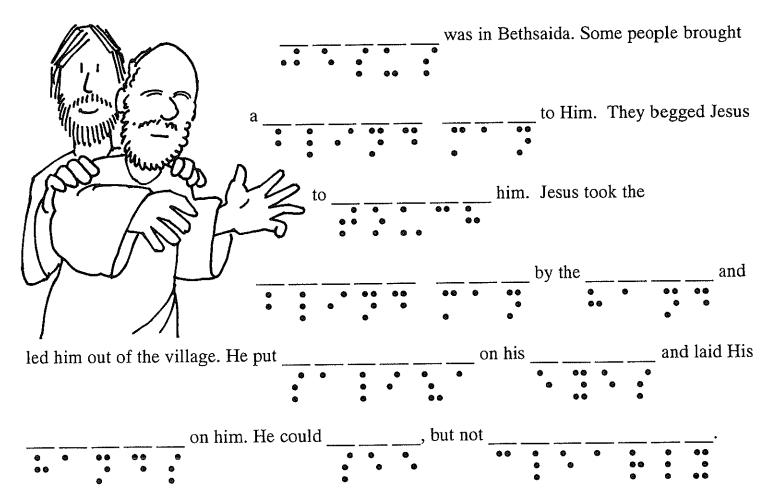

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It's garden season at our farm. With all the rain we've been having this year, my garden adventure has been a trial. It took way longer for me to get things into the garden with all the mud. Once things were in, it seems that the weeds know how to grow in the damp weather much better than my produce. I have completely cleaned out all the weeds three times as my plants grew only a few inches high.

So, tonight we are going to go and put down some weed protection material to help me out. The material we roll out and stake down will drastically take away from the garden workload.

To help what I want to grow, sometimes I need to do some extra work. Sometimes I need to protect my plants from predators like rabbits and deer. Sometimes I need to make sure they aren't overgrown by those darned weeds. Sometimes I have to water them-though not as much this early summer.

Without some work and some tender care, the garden will not prosper. We are reminded that our church community is the same. Congregations do not thrive and stay healthy without some work.

As gardens need basic things to thrive; sunshine, rain, room to grow, and protection from predators, churches also need some basic things to be healthy.

First and foremost, a church needs to be centered and planted right in the rich and healthy Word of God! Having the truths of the Bible to plant our roots in is paramount. But good roots doesn't guarantee you will grow God's church. The church congregation exists in the physical world so we need basic things. We need a church building and it needs care. We need materials to teach the Word and help with worship (like communion supplies). We need to pay our pastor who teaches and leads us. To keep all these things healthy, the congregation needs all your tithes and offerings to our God.

Beyond the physical needs of the church are the needs for fellowship and discipleship. One person with lots of money can still now make a congregation. For a congregation to run healthily, it needs PEOPLE to show up and be a part of the body of Christ. We found out during the Covid years that community is an integral part of being a congregation. People bring a church to life.

To fight the evils and temptations of this world, we need the fellowship of other Christians. One cannot be a church alone. To grow and blossom as we should, the congregation needs YOU!

We hope to see you in church this summer. We need you to remain healthy, run smoothly and spread God's love in our lives and community.
