The Town Board met in regular session on October 3rd, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. at the town fire hall. President Frank Eccles absent, members Kathleen Quale and Dale Bauer present. Quale called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Public communications: kids running around at night, another barking dog, garbage on lawn outside tribal house.

Ciera gave a daycare report.

Maintenance report: bulbs will be ordered for the xmas lights. We will hold off on ordering new lights. A concrete apron quote for \$2,800 was approved for Francis & Maple location.
