The Town Board met in regular session on July 5th, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. at the firehall. President Frank Eccles absent, members Dale Bauer & Kathleen Quale present. Quale called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Public communications: Motion by Quale, second by Bauer to approve a building permit for Larry Hayworth. Motion carried. There was an inquiry about treating gravel for dust. Donn Richter inquired about moving his storage container again that is not allowed as an accessory building in our zoning.
