

Town of Summit

The Town Board met in regular session on June 8th, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. at the town fire hall. President Travis Benthin present and members Frank Redlin & Dale Bauer present. Others present were: Norma Arend-finance officer, Airianna & Allison Benthin, Savannah Moe, Calvin & Becky Pies, Brooke Pies, Jim Thurman, Josh Neuhard, David Cardwell, Kathleen Quale, Mike Tunnissen, Donn Richter, Connie Brotzel, Tom Heinz & Tim Gapp.

Benthin called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Public communications: speeding in town, water draining issue from Blade Johnson, closing main street for Fog Fest.

Motion by Redlin, second by Benthin to approve the May minutes, financial reports and claims with a change per Redlin request Travis will be named as motioning for the tabling of the Conditional Use Permit at the May meeting. Bauer seconded. Since notices needed to be resent, the Conditional Use Permit was tabled to the June meeting. Motion carried. **Insert Claims.**

Old Business: Deputy Sudbeck was in attendance for the monthly sheriff's report.

Mike Tunnissen informed the board he no longer needed a conditional use permit for his food trailer. No action was taken on the conditional use permit or lease proposal previously requested for Tuny's LLC.

Motion by Redlin, second by Bauer to approve building permits for Savannah Moe and Robin Moe. Motion carried.

Tim Gapp was in attendance for the SAEG to request a one day liquor license at the park for Fog Fest July 10th & 11th. Motion by Redlin, second by Bauer to approve the following for Fog Fest: One day liquor license at the park with the SAEG providing security on Saturday July 11th. Sherman street will be closed between the bar and firehall for the street dance Friday night July 10th. Vendors are approved in the park for Fog Fest July 11th. Main (Maple) street will also be closed from Chestnut to Francis during the car show. All aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Bauer, second by Redlin to award the 2026 Summit Street Project with alternates to Duininck, Inc. They were the low bid of \$147,410. Approximately eight blocks will be paved. All aye. Motion carried.

Barking dog complaints were heard.

Motion by Benthin, second by Redlin to sign the engagement letter from ELO CPA's & Advisors to perform the 2024-2025 required audit for the Town of Summit with a cost of \$31,000 plus out of pocket costs. All aye. Motion carried.

Board communications: The Deines mower is surplus and valued at under \$2,500. Notice is not needed to sell the mower. Airianna & Allison Benthin gave the fire department a donation and thanked the fire department for filling their pool with water.

Motion by Benthin, second by Bauer to adjourn meeting. Motion carried. The next regular town board meeting will be Monday, July 6th, 2026 at 7:00pm at the town fire hall.
